*(up to 3 cubic feet or half a truck bed)*

**\$30.00 - \$45.00 per large load**  
*(3 to 9 cubic feet or full pick up truck load)*

**Freon-containing  
appliances:**                    **\$10.00 per unit**

**Tires:**                            **\$1.00 per 16" tire**  
**\$5.00 per 16" to 24" tire**  
**\$15.00 per tire > 24"**

**Business Hazardous Waste: Charged per pound as per vendor pricing**
