## **CLOTHING & HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR REUSE BY VOLUNTEERS OF AMERICA**

- Clothing and textile items in usable condition such as clothing, fabrics, rags, towels, sheets, blankets, linens, draperies/curtains, athletic shoes, purses, handbags and belts.
- Lamps, computers (complete systems in good condition, 2002 and newer), sports equipment, stereo equipment in good working order, televisions and consoles (cable ready and in good condition), dishes, pots & pans, nick nacs, pictures, small furniture items (coffee tables, lamps, etc.), walkers, wheelchairs, bicycles, toys, furniture (no stains, tears or rips), bed frames & headboards, dressers, wooden desks, electric treadmills.
- DO NOT BRING LIST
  - o Nothing wet or soiled, nothing with a foul odor.
  - o Sandals, pump/heels, dress shoes, boots, shoes that light up, metal desks, tires (unless new), mattresses or box springs, waterbeds, bowling balls, car seats, older cribs, gas appliances, gas powered lawn equipment, large appliances

## **REUSEABLE BUILDING MATERIALS AND ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR REUSE BY CLINTON COUNTY HABITAT FOR HUMANITY**

Working Appliances/dishwashers, range tops, washers, dryers, ovens, etc.

Architectural items such as columns, mantel pieces, fireplaces etc.

Bathroom fittings-tubs, sinks, showers, commodes
