### Providers of Subscription Curbside Recycling

**Allied Disposal - (800) 724-5569** Only provides curbside recycling in the eastern half of the southern tier of the townships of DeWitt and Bath area.

**Granger – (517) 372-0555** Provides service for communities in the southern and western tier of the county: those communities to the west of Bauer Road, and all communities south of Cutler Road and west of Wood Road.

**Waste Management, Inc. (800) 796-9696** Provides bi-weekly recycling collection throughout most of the county, except the west end of the northern tier of the townships near the Gratiot County line.
