**** To purchase a three-year license, the rabies vaccination MUST HAVE OCCURRED in 2010 and MUST BE VALID through 2013.** All dogs 4 months and older are required by Michigan Law to be licensed and vaccinated for rabies. The vaccine must be licensed by the United States department of agriculture and **signed by an accredited veterinarian.** Dog Licenses are **NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.**

The cost with penalty for a **Delinquent** license will increase to **\$45.00** for a one-year license and will be prorated for a three-year license. Upon issuance of a ticket, Court Costs of **\$50.00** will also be incurred. Licenses are considered non-delinquent in the following circumstances: a puppy turning 4 months old, a newly acquired dog, or a new resident of Clinton County. Licenses must be purchased within 30 days in order to qualify. **For more information, please contact the Clinton County Treasurer's office at (989) 224-5280 or (888) 224-2450 (press "8" when the message begins).**

RABIES VACCINATION:

Verify that the rabies vaccination is current. You must send the rabies certificate, signed by an accredited veterinarian, with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license.

NEUTER CERTIFICATE:

A veterinarian's certification of sterilization is required for the neutered license. You must send the neuter certificate with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license.
