

**RESOLUTION 2003-11**  
**COUNTY OF CLINTON**  
**YEAR ROUND DOG LICENSE SALES RESOLUTION**  
August 26, 2003

It is hereby resolved by the Clinton County Board of Commissioners, with concurrence of the Clinton County Treasurer, that Clinton County will commence year round sales of dog licenses beginning January 2004.

Clinton County will offer the one (1) year mandatory dog license with the license expiring on the last day of the month in which the rabies vaccination expires one (1) year thereafter.

Clinton County will offer an optional three (3) year dog license with the license expiring on the last day of the month in which the rabies vaccination expires three (3) years thereafter.

All 2003 one (1) year licenses will have their expiration dates adjusted to expire on the last day of the month in which the rabies vaccination expires.

There will be no proration of prior license costs or fees. The method of adjustment to year round sales based on the expiration date of the rabies vaccination will have no negative cost basis for dog owners and will create more convenience and long term cost benefits to Clinton County dog owners.
