## COORDINATOR'S REPORT

April 2015

### Park Improvement Projects

Two Clinton Lakes Park capital improvement projects are now out for bid. A 500' farm fence will separate the maintenance buildings from the walking trail to give a more defined path for visitors and help discourage motorized vehicle use on the trail. The pole barn will also be receiving electrical service.

### Staffing Update

MSU student Rachel McDaniel will be serving as the intern park manager this summer. Rachel is a natural resources recreation and tourism major at MSU and will be helping with a variety of improvement and promotion projects during the operation season.



### Habitat Agreement

The Partners for Fish and Wildlife Habitat Development Agreement was approved by the County and signed by County Administrator Ryan Wood and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Representative Tom Eitnrear. The signing of the agreement will ensure that all parties are free to start preparing for the initial site treatment and planting in order to meet the original schedule.

### **Bluebird Houses at Motz Park**

The adult woodworking group at Community Mental Health will be constructing and placing bluebird houses at Motz Park along the eastern section of trail.

### **Pavilion Reservations**

The pavilion reservations are coming in quickly and we are almost at full capacity for every weekend from Memorial Day to Labor Day. The community is utilizing the versatility of the pavilion as we have reservations for graduation parties, Eagle Scout Courts, family reunions, birthday parties, along with a few community-wide events to be held this summer.
