## COORDINATOR'S REPORT

December 2015

### Culvert Install at Clinton Lakes

The continual buildup of sediment along the lake leveling basin on the north shore of Big Clinton Lake has resulted in the complete stoppage of the movement of water to Little Clinton Lake a number of times during the season. In order to avoid trenching this area multiple times per year, an underwater culvert will be installed in order to keep the basin at the same level as Big Clinton Lake through head pressure. If the weather cooperates, I would like to accomplish this project before the ground is frozen for the winter. The pipe will be covered in loose stone after it is placed in order to trap any future sediment that may pass over while it settles or in the event of a flood.



## **Waterfowl Hunting Program: Wrap-Up**

The 2015 Waterfowl Hunting Program saw successful hunts on the majority of the selected dates. However, approximately two groups were no-shows on each date, taking the opportunity away from other hunting groups who may have applied. If the hunt is to continue into the future, I suggest expanding the selected number of groups from 5 to 6 in order to help curb the no-shows. Also, keeping track of those groups who do not show up and make no attempt to notify the PGSC beforehand will help to establish a list of those hunters who may not be able to apply in future years.

The online survey is still collecting results but I did hear from numerous groups on each date that they would like to see "designated hunting zones" in the park in order to avoid any conflict during their set-up time. Overall, the groups were satisfied with how the program is being run and would like to see it continue into the future.
