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RESOLUTION 2005-3

Soil Erosion & Sedimentation Control

WHEREAS, Part 91, Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 P.A. 451 as amended requires each county to issue a soil erosion and sedimentation permit for a fee; and

WHEREAS, Part 91, Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control also requires each county to make inspections of certain permitted sites such as ponds, seawalls, dredging, etc. for additional inspection fees; and

WHEREAS, many of these projects are already under permit by the DEQ and/or Corps of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, the County of Clinton does not believe its citizens should be charged for duplicate regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners urges the Michigan legislative bodies to amend P.A. 451 as amended to provide counties with the option of waiving soil erosion and sedimentation oversight for those projects that already require a DEQ and/or Corps. of Engineers permit preventing duplicate regulation and duplicate fees charged to county citizens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to State Senator Alan Cropsey, State Representatives Scott Hummel and Richard Ball.
