RESOLUTION 2005-31
AMENDING RESOLUTION 2005-25
ADOPTING APPORTIONMENT REPORT
AUTHORIZING LOCAL UNITS TO SPREAD MILLAGES,
DRAIN AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS CONTAINED
IN THE APPORTIONMENT AND DRAIN REPORTS

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2005-25 at their October 25, 2005 regular meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County RESA Headlee override election was successful on November 8, 2005, increasing the Special Education millage from 2.3857 to 2.6250, in which every taxing unit in Clinton County is affected by this change, and

WHEREAS, there is a correction to be made within the Apportionment Report to school district 19141 located in DeWitt Charter Township changing the millage rate from 4.7500 to 6.4600, and

WHEREAS, the DNR portion of the Apportionment Report required corrections to exclude the Clinton Area Transit millage from the levy since it was new in 2005 and the Clinton County RESA Special Education millage was not rolled up for the DNR parcels, as the State of Michigan will not pay on rates over the 2004 rates, and

WHEREAS, the 2005 total taxable value of real and personal property, subject to taxation in Clinton County remains as previously adopted at \$2,080,730,196

THEREFORE, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners direct each unit to spread:

- 5.7489 mills for Clinton County as adopted on October 25, 2004,
- All mills voted and allocated in various townships, villages and cities for general fund and debt services,
- All mills voted and allocated to various school districts in their respective township or city for operation, state education tax, debt service, special education and vocational education,
- All community colleges,
- All drain taxes authorized and assessed by the Drain Commissioner for various drains,
- All rejected taxes,
- All special assessment districts, lighting and other,
- All delinquent sanitary district assessments,

as outlined in the attached amended reports,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners send copies of this Resolution with attached Revised Apportionment, Drain and Special Assessment Reports to each Township Supervisor and the County Treasurer, further that this Resolution and attachments shall serve as the Certificate required pursuant to MCL 211.38.
