RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HISTORIC DESIGNATION OF OLD US-27

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) pursuant to the Heritage Route Act of 1993 (PA 69 of 1993) is empowered to designate scenic, recreational, and historic highways in the state, and

WHEREAS, the public highway known as Old US-27 extending the length of Clinton County, exhibits exceptional scenic/recreational/historic quality and passes through an area of significant regional importance, providing exposure, visitors and tourism dollars to the city of DeWitt and city of St. Johns, and

WHEREAS, the designation of Old US-27 as a historic highway has the potential to enhance economic activity in the region and promote a greater awareness of the many cities and villages along its route,
