RESOLUTION 2008 - 15

CLINTON COUNTY EMPLOYEE CARPOOLING INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, in May of 2008 the Clinton County Board of Commissioners resolved to establish a Green Government Initiative with the stated goal of reducing county government generated greenhouse gas emissions by 2% per year over the next five years; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners recognize that employee transportation to and from their workplace also contribute to the presence of greenhouse gas emissions; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners are concerned with the high price of vehicle fuels and the financial stress the purchase of such fuels is having on county employees and their families; and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that Clinton County government, its employees and the environment can mutually benefit from transportation alternatives that move employees from single passenger vehicles into shared rides and other environmentally friendly travel alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners recognize that it has a role to play in the establishment and on-going coordination of actions taken to serve employee carpooling and other alternative transportation efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Clinton County Board of Commissioners by itself or in partnership with other area private and public sector employers support the establishment of environmentally sound and financially beneficial employee carpooling and other alternative transportation options ; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Physical Resources Committee shall be charged with recommending best practices, policies and products to accomplish the goal set forth above.
