Supporting the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission

2010-2013 Revised Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS)

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC), in accordance with the guidelines of the United State Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration, has prepared the 2010-2013 Revised Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) with an effective date that begins July 1, 2010, and ends June 30, 2013, for the Michigan Economic Designated District (EDD), composed of the counties of Clinton, Eaton and Ingham; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration (EDA) requires the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission prepare a revised CEDS every three years; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2010, the 2010-2013 Revised CEDS was presented; a review was conducted; and a recommendation for approval was sent to the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission by the Clinton County Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clinton County Board of Commissioners approves the 2010-2013 Revised CEDS, noting the CEDS will benefit communities and businesses in the County and throughout the Tri-County region by providing strategic strategies for regional economic growth and success through the promotion of innovation and competitiveness; the retaining, growing and attracting of businesses; and providing for job creation; and that the 2010-2013 Revised CEDS meets EDA guidelines, consequently providing regional eligibility to apply for EDA grant funding on projects meeting EDA investment priorities.
