## RESOLUTION 2014-15 IN HONOR OF COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH'S 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

**WHEREAS**, the Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties (CEI) is a public governmental body, formed by the County Commissions of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties, with a 12 member Board of Directors appointed by the County Commissions of all three counties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties (CEI) has worked, for the past fifty years, to ensure that Michigan's citizens, especially the most vulnerable, have access to full citizenship and to high quality mental health and substance abuse services and supports; and

**WHEREAS**, in its Community Mental Health Services Program (CMHSP) role, CMH serves, through the work of its staff (over 1,000 employees) and its contractual providers (over 600 employees of these providers), the mental health and related needs of approximately 11,000 residents of the tri-county region, drawn from four populations:

- Children and adolescents with emotional disturbance
- Adults with mental illness
- Adults, children, and adolescents with developmental disabilities
- Persons with substance abuse disorders; and

**WHEREAS**, CEI has shown a strong commitment to our community by providing a comprehensive array of services including: psychiatry, counseling, nursing, occupational therapy, speech therapy, dietetics, case management and supports coordination, housing assistance, employment assistance, crisis services, crisis stabilization services, outreach to vulnerable and hard-to-reach populations, wrap-around services, and parent education.
