## RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF COUNTY EQUALIZATION 2002

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee acting in its capacity as the Equalization Committee has recommended adoption of the **Total County Equalized Value of \$1,981,667,547**,

WHEREAS, all classes of real and personal property have been separately equalized in accordance with Michigan Compiled Law Section 211.34,

WHEREAS, the Equalization Committee has recommended the adoption of the County Equalized Values by Class as follows:
