The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Drainage District boundaries and Apportionment of benefit for the Drain with the Drain Commissioner or a staff member. A map of the proposed Drainage District boundary revisions can be found on the reverse side of this notice and online at the Clinton County Drain Commissioner's website at: www.clinton-county.org/250/Drain-Commissioners-Office/.

The Drain Commissioner, engineers, and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals throughout the day and make revisions where necessary. Masks are required to enter the Courthouse and social distancing guidelines will be in effect. There is no need to schedule an appointment for a specific time on the Day of Review. The computation of costs for the Drain will also be available at the Day of Review. Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the phone number listed above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing or other assistance.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Clinton County Circuit Court within ten (10) days, and you may also appeal the determination of apportionments to the Clinton County Probate Court within ten (10) days.

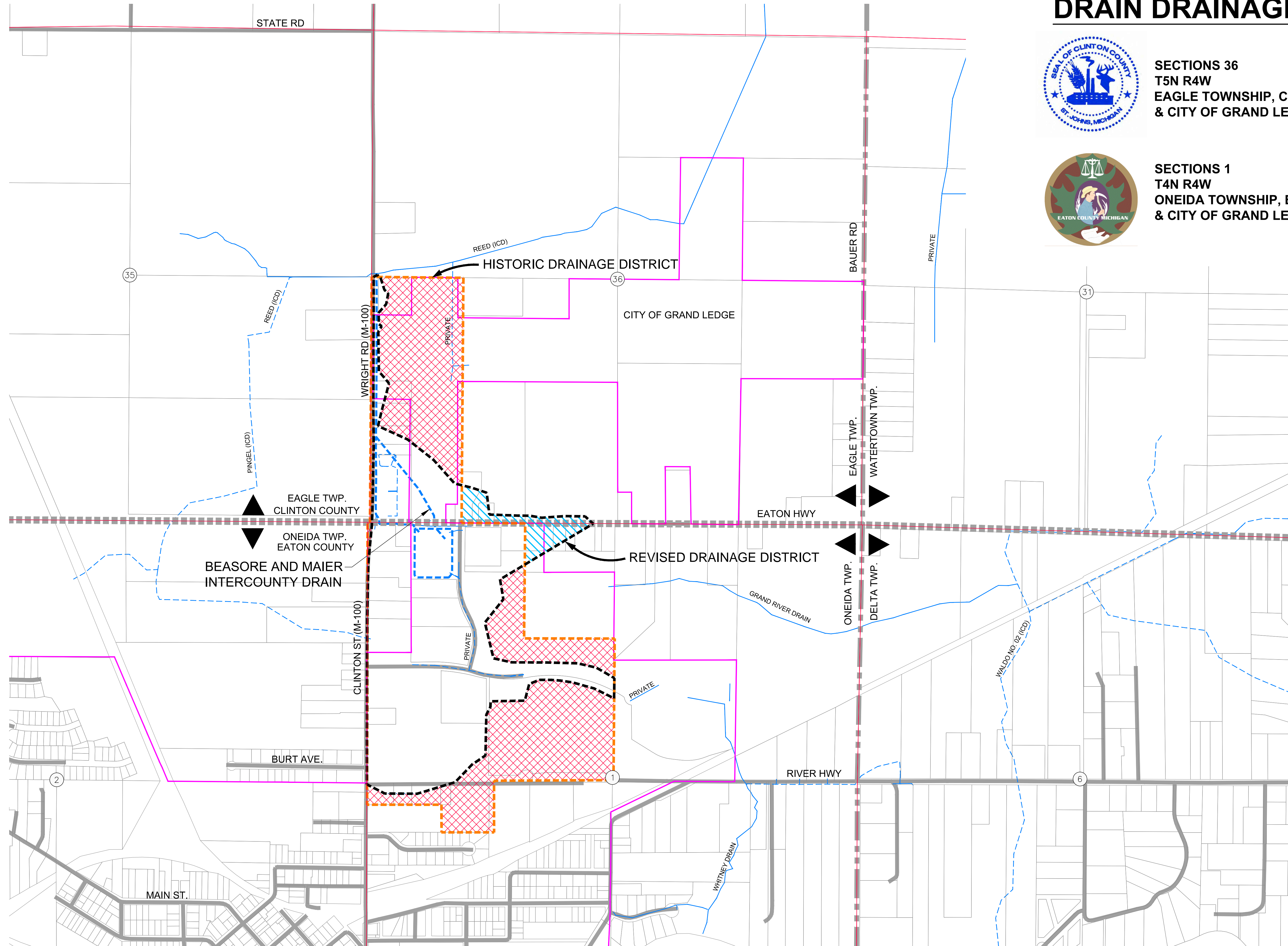
BEASORE AND MAIER INTERCOUNTY DRAIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT

& CITY OF GRAND LEDGE

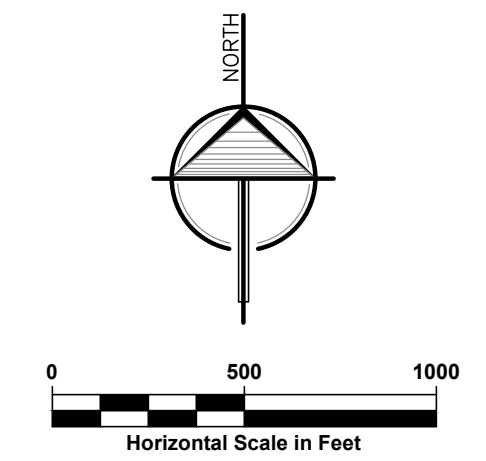
