What & How To Recycle

The Following Items are Collected by East Lansing for Recycling:

1) Glass – Brown, Green and Clear food/beverage jars and bottles only.

⊗ We Do Not accept blue or yellow glass, ceramic, Pyrex, window glass, light bulbs or dishes.

How to prepare your recyclable glass:

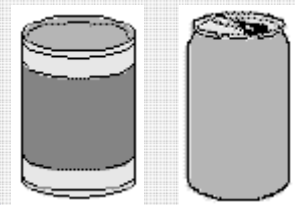
- ✓ Rinse clean and remove excess food residue
- ✓ Do not break (for safety sake)
- ✓ Remove lids (metal lids can be recycled with tin/steel cans)
- ✓ Separate glass by color at drop-off sites



2) Tin/Aluminum Cans/Foil – Tin (steel) & aluminum cans, trays, pie tins & foil accepted.

How to prepare your tin/aluminum cans/foil:

- ✓ Rinse clean and remove excess food residue
- ✓ Remove and discard plastic lids
- ✓ Place metal lids inside of can for safe handling
- ✓ EMPTY household metal aerosol cans (accepted curbside only)



3) Plastic – #1 -#7 plastics (bottles, cups & tubs)

We DO NOT accept the following plastic items:

- ⊗ Automotive fluid bottles (oil, antifreeze, etc.)
- ⊗ Plastic bags



How to Prepare your plastic bottles:

- ✓ Rinse clean and remove food residue
- ✓ Remove and discard caps, flatten if possible

4) Glossy Magazines – Magazines and catalogs with shiny/glossy pages.

☹ We DO NOT accept phone books, paper board (boxboard), and wrapping paper.

How to prepare your glossy magazines:

- ✓ Keep magazines, mixed paper and newspaper separate from each other
- ✓ Cover curbside bins in inclement weather to prevent blowing and/or getting wet

5) Newspaper – Newspaper and Inserts.

☹ We DO NOT accept paper board (boxboard), and wrapping paper.



How to prepare your newspaper:

- ✓ Keep newspaper, mixed paper and magazines separate from each other
- ✓ Remove and discard plastic delivery bags
- ✓ Cover curbside bins in inclement weather to prevent blowing and/or getting wet

6) Mixed Paper – Junk mail, white & colored envelopes, envelopes with or without windows, brochures, letterhead, copier paper, etc.

We DO NOT accept the following paper items:

- ☹ Thermal, carbon, construction, wrapping or tissue paper
- ☹ Plastic envelopes such as Tyvek, cereal boxes, or metal clips



How to prepare your mixed paper:

- ✓ Keep it separate from magazines and newspaper
- ✓ Remove binding, paper clips, metal clips, etc. (staples are O.K. to leave in)
- ✓ Cover curbside bins in inclement weather to prevent blowing and from getting wet

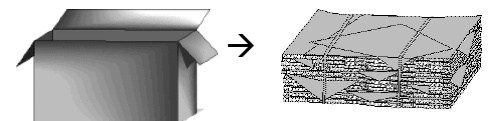
7) Brown Paper Grocery Bags & Corrugated Cardboard

☹ We DO NOT accept boxboard/paper board (i.e. cereal boxes, gift boxes) and Styrofoam

How to prepare corrugated cardboard and brown paper grocery bags:

- ✓ Break down boxes and flatten

Corrugated Cardboard Accepted at the Drop-off Sites Only.

8) Household Batteries – We DO NOT accept batteries

Recahrgable batteries can be dropped off at the DPW building located at 1800 E. State Road



9) Cell Phones – Working and non-working cell phones and battery chargers.

How to prepare your cell phones:

- ✓ Cell phones in working condition can be dropped off at the Hannah Community Center – Seniors Program for re-use. Please include the battery charger.
- ✓ Non working cell phones can be recycled at the DPW Recycling Site, 1800 E. State Rd. Drop off phones and chargers in the appropriately labeled containers outside at the Recycling Site.

10) Athletic Shoes – All brands of athletic shoes.

How to prepare your old sneakers:

- ✓ Shoes should be relatively clean and free of mud/dirt
